

1 Amend PART 1 – INTERPRETATION by appending the following to clause 1:

“Adult” is a person who has reached the age of majority as defined by the *Age of Majority Act*

“Minor” is a person who has not reached the age of majority as defined by the *BC Age of Majority Act*

“Player” is a person registered to play soccer on a Team, or, a registered participant in a Canada Soccer Long Term Player Development (LTPD) group affiliated with the Association.

“Player’s Household” is the group of people consisting of a minor player, his parents, guardians, and minor siblings with whom the minor player regularly resides.

“Adult Household Representative” is a person designated at the time of registration of a Minor Player to act as a representative at meetings of the Association.

“Adult Team” is a Team affiliated with the Association whose Players are predominately made up of people who have reached the age of majority as defined by the *Age of Majority Act*

2 Amend Part 2 – Membership by removing the text of clauses 4 and 5 by substituting:

- 4 The members of the Society are the applicants for incorporation of the Society and those persons who subsequently have become members in accordance with the Bylaws of the Association and, in either case, have not ceased to be members.
- 5 There are 3 classes of members:
 - a. Honorary Life Membership may be granted to persons who, in the opinion of the Board of Directors of the Association have contributed their services in such a manner as to warrant such recognition.
 - b. The following are Regular Members:
 - i. applicants for incorporation of the Society
 - ii. members of the Board of Directors of the Association
 - iii. Honorary Life Members
 - iv. registered adult players
 - v. registered volunteers
 - vi. registered minor players and the members of the minor player’s household
 - c. The following shall be voting members:
 - i. applicants for incorporation of the Society
 - ii. members of the Board of Directors of the Association
 - iii. Honorary Life Members
 - iv. up to two adult persons per Adult Team, one of whom may be the Coach of the Adult Team, who are appointed by the Coach of the Adult Team, in accordance with this paragraph, to be the representatives of the Adult Team for the Soccer Season. Each Coach shall appoint the representatives for the Coach's Adult Team and notify the Association, in writing, of the names and addresses of the representatives appointed by no later than January 31 of the Soccer Season. If any Adult Team representatives ceases to be a member during the Soccer Season, the Coach may appoint another representative in that person's place.

- v. One Adult Household Representative for each registered minor player's household
- vi. Registered adult volunteers granted voting rights by the Board in recognition of significant and extraordinary contributions made to the Association

Persons qualifying as voting members pursuant to more than one of the above mentioned categories shall only be entitled to one vote at a meeting of members and be regular members in good standing for at least 30 days prior to the date of a meeting of members.

Amend Part 2 – Membership by appending the following to the text of clause 8:

(d) on expiry of the registration with the Association that granted regular membership. Registrations are annual and for the Soccer Season registered. Regular Membership expires 31 days after the end of the registered Soccer Season (August 31).
